

CLEAN COMMUTE DAY 2009
OFFICIAL RULES

1. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY.
2. SPONSORS: Commuter Information will be giving away prizes donated by local sponsors for the “Clean Commute Pledge” contest. List of prizes is available at www.commuterinformation.com. Contest void where prohibited or otherwise restricted by law. 3. HOW TO ENTER/ENTRY DEADLINE: Beginning April 20, get a pledge card through a participating employer, Clean Commute Day event or www.commuterinformation.com and register your pledge for Clean Commute Day.
4. ELIGIBILITY RESTRICTIONS: You must be 18 years or older. One prize per household allowed. Employees of Commuter Information, Thomas Jefferson Planning District Commission, RideShare, JAUNT, CTS, UTS, Greene County Transit, American Lung Association, subsidiaries, advertising, print or promotion agencies and their immediate families of each are not eligible to win. The term “immediate families” includes only spouses, parents and children.
5. SELECTION OF WINNERS: Winners will be drawn from registrations received by Commuter Information in a drawing held on or after May 1, 2009.
6. PRIZES: Commuter Information reserves the sole discretion to select the prizes. The winner must come to Commuter Information to receive their prize.
